AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for all placements - 1st thru NBQ, Best of Breed, and Best in Field (Sunday only)

TRIAL HOURS: 6:00 A.M. until 1 hour after completion of the last scored course of the day (both days)

ROLL CALL AND INSPECTION: 8:30 A.M. FOR ALL BREEDS BOTH DAYS

Entries will **NOT** be acknowledged by mail.

DAY OF TRIAL entries **WILL** be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to roll call the day of the trial.

ELIGIBILITY: Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzois, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds Sloughis, and Whippets may be entered. All entries shall be individually registered with the American Kennel Club, the National Greyhound Association, the Federation Cynologique Internationale, an ASFA- recognized foreign or ASFA board approved registry, or possess a critique registration number (CRN) from the Society for the Perpetuation of the Desert Bred Saluki (SPDBS).

LIMITED STAKES: Only purebred Chart Polski, Galgo Espanols, Magyars Agars, Peruvian Inca Orchid, and Cirneco dell'Etna, and Portuguese Podengos may be entered. All entries shall be individually registered with the appropriate registry.

Incomplete, unsigned, conditional, or late entries will NOT be accepted. Substitutes for lame or in-season hounds are allowed if the substitute has the same owner and the Field Secretary is notified by 7:30 A.M. the day of the trial.

Stakes & Classes Offered:

OPEN STAKE – Any eligible sighthound that has met certification requirements excluding **ASFA** Field Champions of record.

FIELD CHAMPION STAKE - Any **ASFA** Field Champion

VETERAN STAKE - Any eligible hound 6 years of age or older (5 years for Irish Wolfhounds, 7 years for Rhodesian Ridgebacks and Whippets), that has met certification requirements.

LIMITED STAKES - Any eligible sighthound of a Limited or Provisional stake breed that has met certification requirements.

SINGLE STAKE – Open to any eligible sighthound including those disqualified to run in other stakes.

BEST IN FIELD **WILL** BE OFFERED ON **SUNDAY ONLY** WCLCC is proud to offer the "SLIGO" challenge trophy Donated by Barbara Sciarra. The trophy remains in the possession of WCLCC permanently but a memento of the Win will be given to the BIF winner.

All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial. Stakes will be split if the entry in any one stake is 20 or more at the time of the draw. All hounds will be run twice, in trios if possible, or braces, unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.

Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be excused. Bitches known to be in season should NOT be brought onto the trial grounds. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched.

Practice and Certifications will be run Saturday only, time/weather/and equipment permitting after the completion of all events at a cost of \$2.00 per run per dog for practice, \$5.00 per certification run. A battery-powered, continuous loop system will be used. Back-up equipment will be available. The lure will consist of highly visible plastic strips and/or fur.

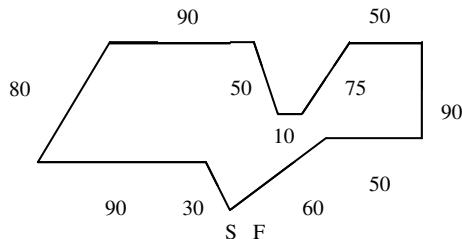
There will be a \$5 fine for any loose dog on the field, which is not in the course in progress.

WCLCC reserves the right to alter the course plan as necessary due to weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.

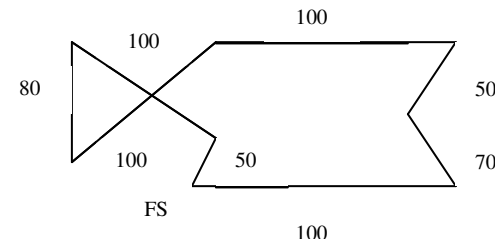
The course will be reversed for finals, and reversed again for runoffs and Best of Breed.

Directions- From I-65, exit Crown Point Rte 231 and go east on Rte 231 (away from Crown Point) about 3 miles. Just past the small town of Leroy, turn left (north) on 145th Ave. There is a Stoney Run Park sign at this intersection. Follow 145th Ave about 2 miles to park (on left). There may be a charge per vehicle, charged by the park. The park gate will be unlocked at 7 a.m.
 If coming from the east, take Rte 2 from Valparaiso south to Hebron. In Hebron turn right (west) on Rte 231. Go about 4 miles to Stoney Run Park sign. Turn right and when the road makes a "T", go right again and follow to the park.

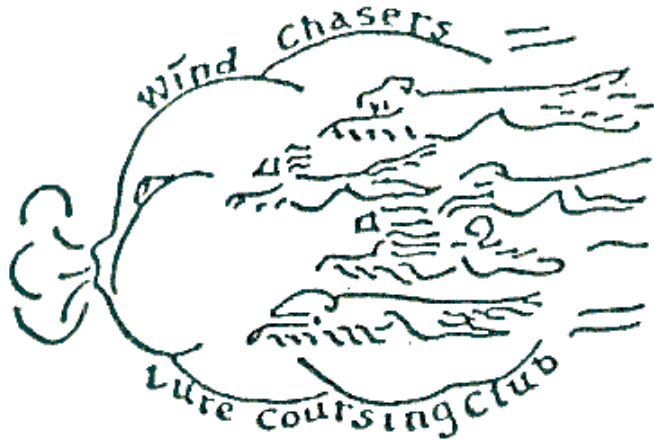
